Fort Foote Elementary: Science Bowl Winners!

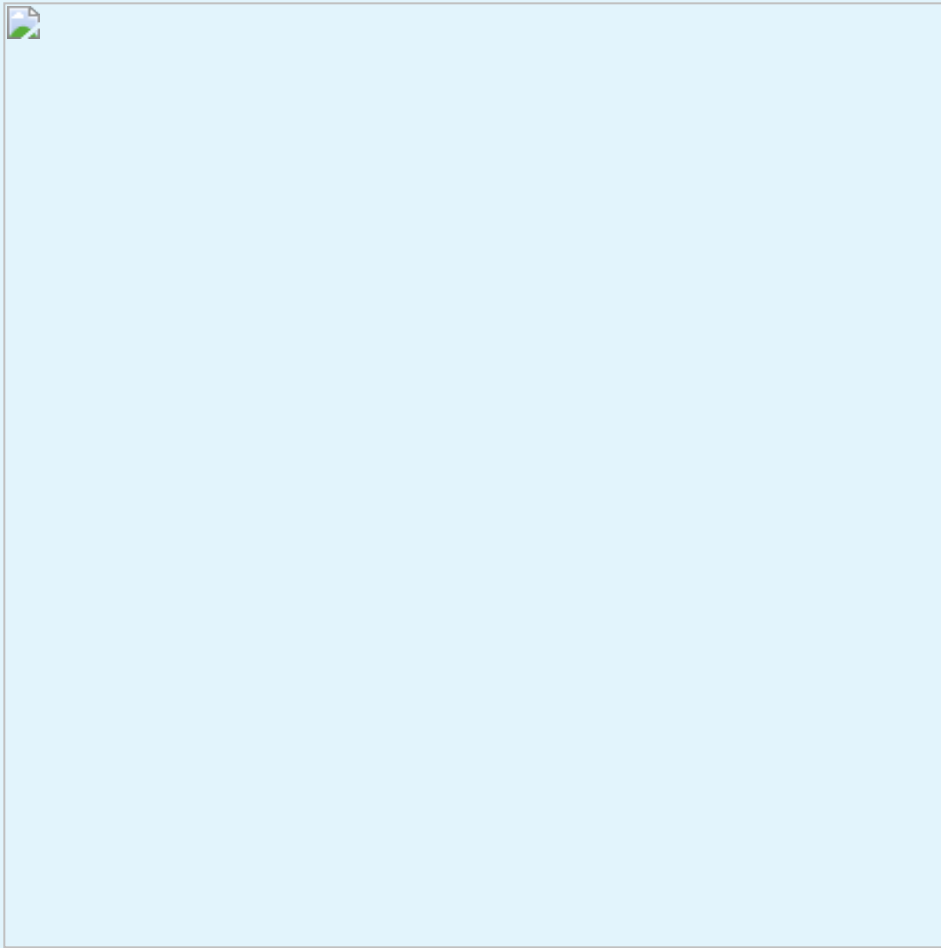
