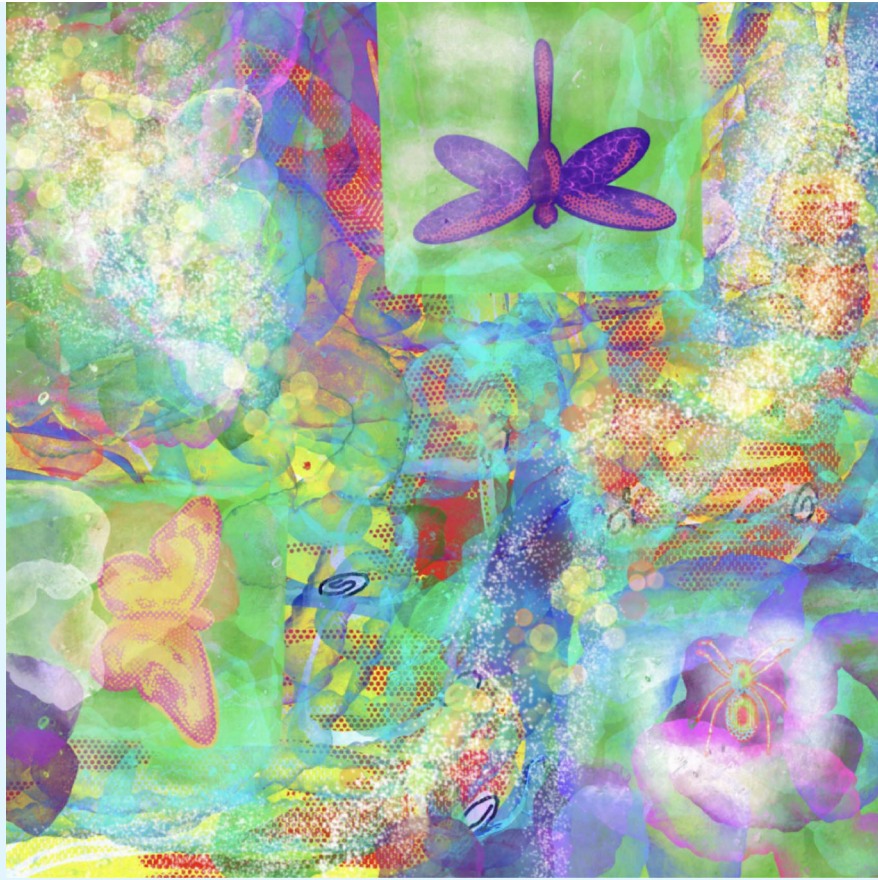

**Third Annual Virtual Art Exhibit Highlights Student Work**

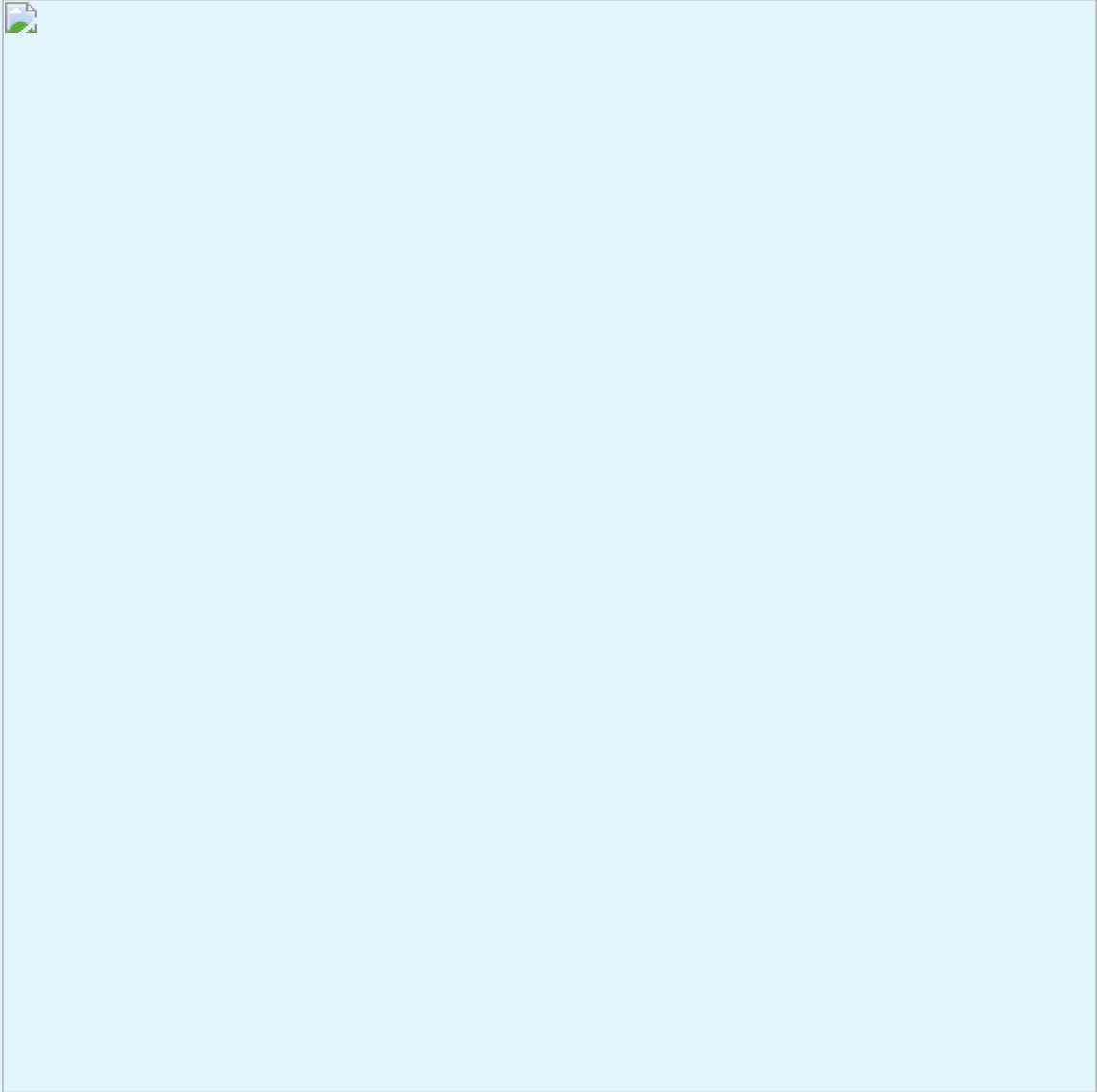

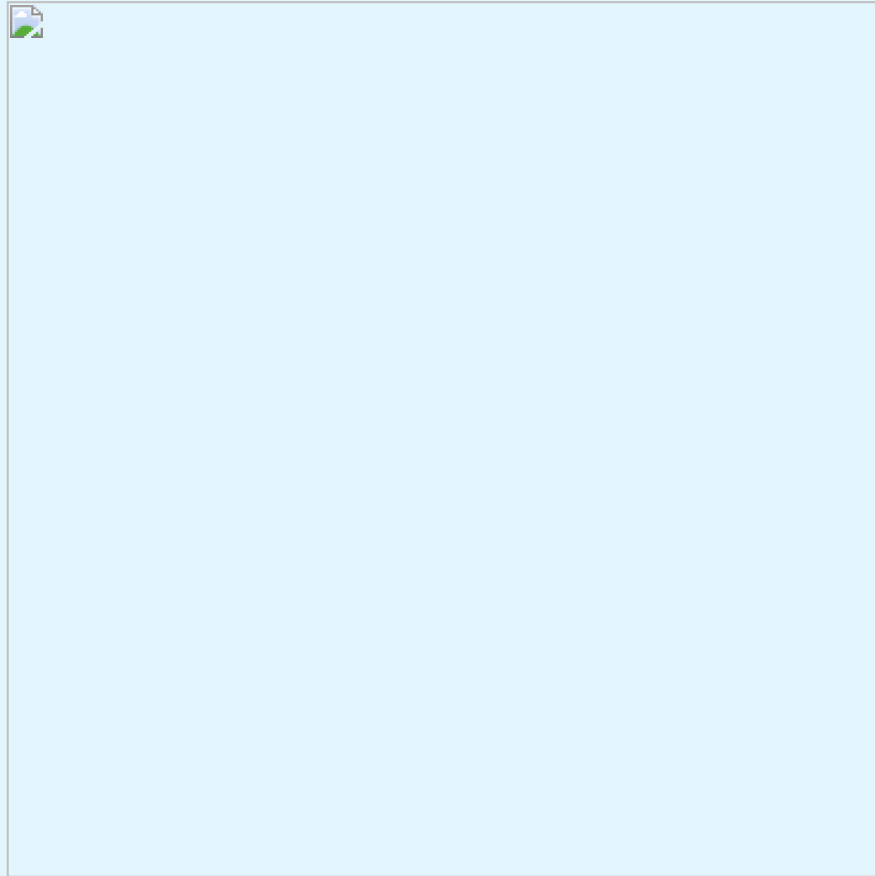

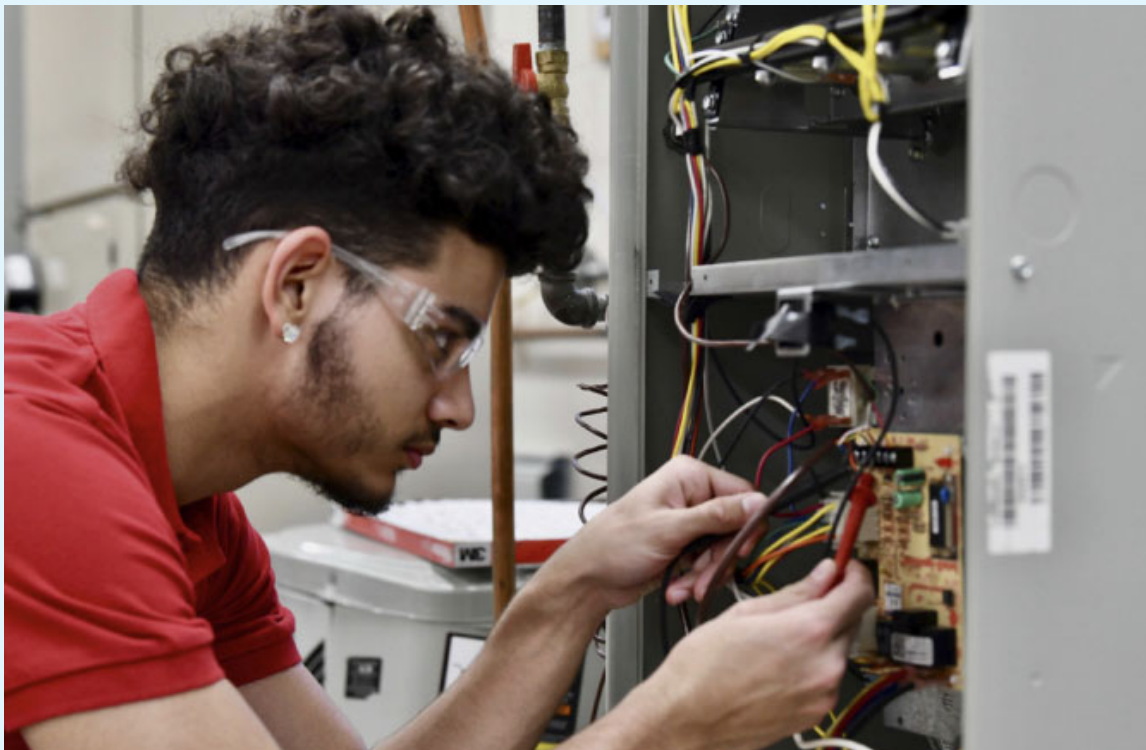
