PGCPS is excited to announce our new partnership with [Hazel Health](#) that will allow students to complete urgent medical care visits or therapy sessions virtually!

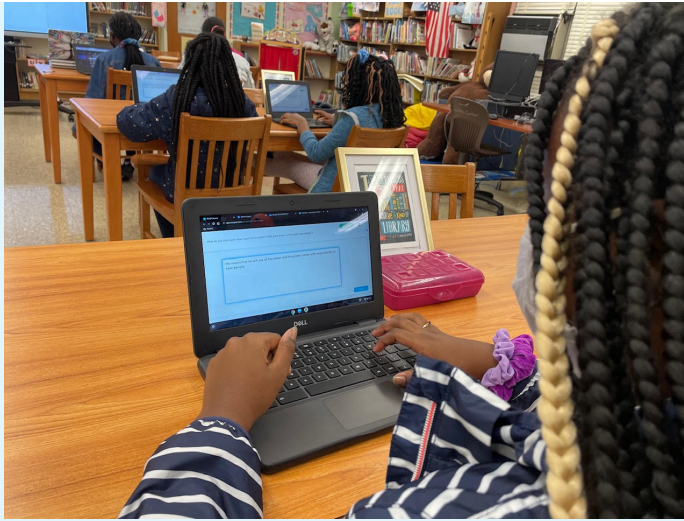

Prince George's County has enacted a [30-day curfew](#) for youth ages 16 and under. During this time, extended hours at community centers and additional activities are available.
