
### **School Operations**

- Electrification: PGCPS has ordered 20 electric buses and will continue the transition to an all electric bus fleet.

































## No Parking Zones





















Cars will not be allowed to turn left as they exit. Cars will have to go through the roundabout to turn left on Fort Washington Road







### Safety and Security Update

### **School Resources Officers & Staffing**

- There is currently no School Resource Officer(SRO) assigned to this school, but the area SRO and School Safety Overtime Officer will make visits.
- We have requested two Safety and Security Assistants for this school and will monitor service requests to determine any additional needs.
- Currently, we have assigned at least two safety and security staff members to select middle and K-8.
- We are planning to add staff to all new middle schools as they come online.
- All high schools have safety and security staff assigned.

### **Security Cameras**

- The Office of Safety and Security monitors all PGCPS property and school alarms.
- We have real time access to all camera feeds and direct access to Public Safety Communications.
- Generally, maintenance for cameras and alarm systems are handled by the Office of Safety and Security. (This is a special circumstance)



### Safety and Security Update

#### **Drills & Exercises**

- The state of Maryland School Safety Act requires the below listed drills each quarter. Drills 1 through 4 are components of the active shooter drills. Although we do not require active shooter drills for students, Safety and security personnel partner with law enforcement agencies to practice and ensure we are current with local, state and federal best practices.
- Required Drills
  - Evacuation:
  - Shelter in place;
  - Reverse evacuation;
  - Lock down;
  - o Drop, cover, and hold; and
  - Severe weather

### **Enhanced Safety Devices**

• As we evaluate the safety and security equipment, we will determine the next steps and additional schools to receive enhancements.



### School Building & Move Update

### **Public Spaces & Fields**

- All fields are open to the public and available for use during non-school hours.
- None of the fields have lights.
- Public groups and/or organized activities will not be able to reserve school facilities until May.

### **Community Health Center**

- To date, there is no identified vendor to operate the Community Health Center.
- The vendor will enter into an MOU/Agreement with County Department of Health when selected.

### **Move Management**

- Preparations have begun with department leadership and will soon begin with existing staff at Potomac Landing Elementary School and Isaac Gourdine Middle School.
- Non-essential instructional materials will start being delivered in early November with the bulk of the move occurring the 3 days preceding Thanksgiving.
