






Our Commitment

Project Scope

Phase I

Construction of a new school in front of the existing Cool Spring Elementary School while the existing school is in operation. The proposed school, including the Judy Center is anticipated to be three floors and accommodate 900 students. The new school will be built to be energy efficient and meet all current building and accessibility codes.

Phase II

After completion of the new school, the school portion of the existing building will be demolished and a new building will be constructed consisting of a Therapy Pool, Central Administration spaces for ESOL, International Admissions, Bilingual, and Translation services as well as the community program for Family Support Center.

Phase III

Staff for the Phase II spaces will move in. Afterward the old convent building will be demolished and final sitework will be completed including site access and playfield improvements.

Fall 2023 - Spring 2024	Design
Summer 2024 - Fall 2024	Permitting
Fall 2024	Bidding
Late Fall/Winter 2024	Construction Phase 1
SY 2025 - 26	Occupancy (Completion Phase 1)
Summer 2026	Construction Phase 2
Fall 2027	Completion Phase 2



Current Status

Educational Specifications

- Outlines the types, numbers, and sizes of spaces to support the educational program.
- Includes spaces for a Judy Center, a Family Center, and PGCPS support functions like ESOL.

Feasibility Study

- Developed 3 concept plans with cost estimates for the proposed project.
- Board approval scheduled for October 26, 2023.

Schematic Design

- First phase of of a project design which determines the areas, physical requirements, and relationships of all the required building spaces and components.
- Confirms/ revises the total building square footage and the total project budget, as well as the project schedule and occupancy dates.

RFP for CM services

 Request for Proposal for professional construction manager (CM) services to provide school system with effective management of schedule, cost, quality, safety, and function of the project.





For the Project

- Feasibility Study is going to the Board tomorrow.
- Educational Specification is almost complete
- Schematic design will continue.
- Meetings with PGCPS and School Leadership.
