The project will provide up to 2,600 student high




Current Status

- Planning funds approved by State of Maryland to finalize educational specifications and begin architectural design.
- New Northern Area High School (NNAHS) will become new CTE hub for northern part of county.
- Some of the CTE pathways from High Point HS will be relocated to NNAHS.
- High Point HS will continue to offer CTE pathways.
- Developing the educational specifications:
 - Outlines the types, numbers, and sizes of spaces to support the educational program.
 - Meeting with PGCPS Instructional leadership to confirm programs
 - Site visits to other high schools to learn best practices

Anticipated Project Timeline



Building Construction Phase				
Regular Community Meetings

Anticipated completion date: School year 2030-2031

- Will depend on funding availability, permitting, technical issues (e.g. soils)
- Students will be in located in New Northern High School while this project is under construction.

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Next Steps

- Finalize educational specifications:
 - Documents the number, size, and relationships of required instructional and support spaces.
 - Expert input from instructional and support staff and school-level staff.
 - Review with all parties before finalizing.
 - Board of Education approval.
- Discussions with permitting agencies.
- Continue application for funding:
 - Funds for planning and design have been approved.
 - Will involve a number of annual cycles (typical for large projects).
- Architectural Design:
 - Physical relationship of all elements of the educational specification.
 - School and community input at critical stages of design.
