Graduation Requirements

Graduating Classes of 2005 through 2008

Total Credits Needed: 21
(4 credits must be earned beyond grade 11)

- English: 4 credits (English 9, English 10, English 11, English 12)
- Mathematics: 3 credits (Algebra 1, Geometry, 1 additional credit)
- Science: 3 credits (Biology, 2 additional science credits)
- Social Studies: (US History, LSN Government, World History)
- Fine Arts: 1 credit
- Technology Education: 1 credit
- Health: .5 credits
- Physical Education: .5 credits
- Completer: 2 to 4 credits (Choices: 2 credits of same Foreign Language, 2 credits of Advanced Technology, or Complete a State-approved career and technology program)

Students must attend school for four years beyond grade 8 and complete a minimum of 36 Service-Learning hours. Students must take the High School Assessments for English10, Algebra, Biology, and Government.

Graduating Class beginning Class of 2009

The requirements are the same except the students must **pass** the High School Assessments.
