

HSA Passing Score Update

Good Morning,

Just when you thought you had it all down.... Here is an update on the passing requirements for the High School Assessments.

“The State Board voted today (October 31, 2007) to maintain the 4 HSAs as a graduation requirement for students who entered grade 9 in 2005, graduating in 2009. The Board eliminated the minimum score on each test, and voted to support the Bridge Plan.”

In other words, students must still take all four assessments and make a 1602 combined score, however they could get for example, a 240 on the Algebra HSA and as long as their other tests are high enough to make a total of 1602 they qualify for graduation. This change will affect a number of students who at one time had a 1602 or above but did not make the minimum on one or more tests.
