General Information

Starting and Ending Dates: First semester, Evening High School begins on September 4, 2007, and ends on December 20, 2007. Second semester Evening High School begins on January 22, 2008, and ends on May 22, 2008. First semester, Saturday School begins on September 8, 2007, and ends on December 15, 2007. Second semester Saturday School begins on January 26, 2008, and ends on May 24, 2008.

Types of Credit: Original Credit - Courses taken for the FIRST time by the student. Original credit courses may be taken in Evening or Saturday classes only starting September 2007. No Original Credit classes will be offered during the second semester for Term Length classes.

Repeat Credit - Courses that the student has taken previously, i.e., student was previously enrolled in a course having the same course number.

Types of Classes: Year Length Classes - Classes meet either Monday and Wednesday evenings, Tuesday and Thursday evenings or Saturday mornings beginning September 4, 2007 through May 24, 2008.

Semester Length Classes - Classes meet Monday and Wednesday evenings or Tuesday and Thursday evenings from September 4, 2007 through December 20, 2007, or from January 22, 2008 to May 22, 2008.

Term Length Classes - One-credit courses in English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies that are taught in a semester through extended class hours and accelerated study. HSA courses will not be offered for Original Credit in Term Length courses. Preference is given to seniors. Term length classes meet on Mondays and Wednesdays or Tuesdays and Thursdays beginning January 22, 2008 to May 22, 2008.

Attendance: Absences shall be determined to be excused or unexcused by the same policies used during the regular day school year. Students who miss in excess of four (4) unexcused absences in any semester of a Year or Semester Length class, or two (2) unexcused absences in any semester of a Term Length class will be in danger of withdrawal and not receiving credit for the course. Students who have pre-existing medical conditions that might impact attendance should provide documentation of such at the time of registration. Refunds of tuition fees will not be given for students withdrawn from the Evening/Saturday High School program.

Transfer Students: All county/state transfer procedures must be followed. Students must report to the Evening High School within three school days of the transfer date from their home school.

General Information

Regular Evening/Saturday High School Students:

At the time of registration, new regular students not enrolled in day school need a completed unofficial transcript, PDS cards that include standardized and HSA testing student information, and immunization records. These documents may be obtained from their base school.

Concurrently Enrolled Students: Students must submit a completed Evening/Saturday High School Registration Form at the time of registration. Forms are available in all high schools. They must include the nine-digit student ID number, the five-digit school number, course number(s), and required signatures.

Cancellation of Classes: If classes are cancelled at a center due to insufficient enrollment, students may transfer to another subject or center where the class is offered.

TUITION and REGISTRATION FEES ARE TO BE PAID IN FULL WHEN THE STUDENT REGISTERS. Only money orders (payable to Prince George's County Public Schools) will be accepted. (No personal or certified checks, cash, or credit cards.)

Students who withdraw from the day school program to attend Evening High School exclusively will pay only the \$25 registration fee. If the student has paid the regular fee for the course(s) and then withdraws from day school, no money will be refunded. Students who are 21 years of age or older must pay the specified fees per course.

Waivers: Students eligible for tuition waivers may not have their tuition waived by more than 40% (from \$450 to \$270 for a one credit course and from \$225 to \$135 for a ½ credit course). Only those students in the most extreme financial circumstances will be approved using school system eligibility standards. The Tuition Waiver Request Form, completed and signed by the day school principal, must be submitted at the time of registration. Final approval will be granted by the Evening High School principal. The registration fee of \$25 must be paid in full by all students, even those receiving tuition waivers. A waiver may be given for only one course per semester.

Graduation: All students will receive a diploma from their base school at the Evening High School graduation ceremony. The day school must provide the student with an Evening/Saturday High School Registration Form **EVEN THOUGH THE STUDENT MAY NOT BE CONCURRENTLY ATTENDING THAT DAY SCHOOL.**
