

## Laurel High School's Acceptable Internet Use Form - Student Contract

The computers at Laurel High School are important tools that can help us learn and do well in school. They are not toys and they may not be used for games. Students are not permitted to access email while in school.

Before you use the computers, and the Internet, you must know the computer rules, which are listed below. If you agree to follow the rules, you will receive your Internet sticker, which will be affixed, to your student ID. If you are not wearing your ID, you may NOT use a computer. Students without an Internet sticker will not be permitted to go online.

Your Internet sticker gives you the right to use the Internet to search for information for school assignments. If you break the rules, your sticker will be taken away and you will not be allowed to access the Internet for **ANY** reason.

Put a ✓ next to each statement.

I will use the computers and the Internet for school assignments <b>ONLY</b> .	
I will only use the Internet with a teacher's permission and with adult supervision.	
I will use appropriate language and display appropriate behavior at all times.	
I will not give out information such as my name, address, phone number or parents' work address while on the Internet.	
I will not damage any part of a disk or computer.	
I will not plagiarize other people's work. If I use someone else's words or ideas, I will cite the source correctly.	
I will not waste school resources such as computer paper, ink, or disks.	
I will not access personal email or "chat rooms" unless directed by a teacher to do so.	
I will not access online material that is obscene or inappropriate at any time.	
I will not download any computer files unless authorized by a teacher.	
I will <b>NEVER</b> do anything illegal nor will I hurt or insult another person.	
I will not eat, drink or chew gum while using a computer.	

### A NEW FORM MUST BE COMPLETED EACH SCHOOL YEAR.

**Consequences:** If you break any of these rules, your Internet sticker will be revoked for a period of time or taken away for good. You may **NOT** use the Internet without your Internet sticker. Any teacher or administrator may also decide that other disciplinary action (including detention, Saturday school, or suspension) should be taken, as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct.
