

# Northwestern High School Coat Policy

In an effort to maintain a safe and orderly environment, all coats must be stored in lockers. Students may not wear coats in the classroom or in the school building except for the following-

- Arriving to school in the morning
- During their lunch period for the purpose of going outside
- Departing school for the day

A coat is defined as every outer garment.

The following garments can be worn only one at a time in the school and/or classroom-

- Sweater
- Fleece
- Light jacket

The following fall under the category "light jacket":

- Blazer, suit jacket
- Windbreaker
- Closely cut leather jacket that is part of an outfit

**This policy does not supersede the REVISED Northwestern High School Enhanced Dress Code as described herein.** Any issues or concerns will be handled at the discretion of the administrative team. Teachers will not permit students to enter classrooms wearing coats. Wearing or bringing a coat to class will be considered insubordination and will result in administrative action being taken.
