Bus Transportation

Riding a school bus is a privilege which may be revoked for dangerous or unsatisfactory conduct on the bus. Please be sure to adhere to the following rules:

- Don't throw objects from the bus.
- No smoking, eating, or drinking on buses.
- Ride only the bus to which you are assigned.
- Remain seated while the bus is in motion; keep the noise level down by talking in normal conversational tones and maintain normal classroom standards of behavior.
- Do not extend arms, hands, head, or any object from the bus.
- Do not run in front of or behind the school bus. Always stop and look for traffic before crossing the street.
- Be at your designated bus stop at least fifteen minutes prior to the pick-up time. Do not expect your driver to wait for you. *Missing the bus is not considered an excused absence or tardy from school.*
