COMMEMORATING WORLD SPACE WEEK  
OCTOBER 4-10, 2003  
PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

**WHEREAS**, the United Nations has declared October 4 - 10, 2003, as World Space Week to celebrate and focus on the contributions that the science of Space Research, Exploration and Technology continues to make to the betterment of society; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Prince George's County Space and Flight Center will further complement the work of private industry and the federal government by coordinating the development of educational programs in the areas of Space Research, Exploration and Technology for students, teachers and the general public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education of Prince George’s County, hereby proclaims October 4 – 10, 2003, as World Space Week in Prince George’s County and urges students and teachers to undertake activities during World Space Week and throughout the school year that celebrate and bring focus to the contributions that the science of Space Research, Exploration and Technology continues to make to the betterment of society in Prince George’s County, the State of Maryland and throughout the nation.
