The Prince George's County Police Seek Police Cadets

Prince George's County, Maryland.... The Prince George's County Police Department is seeking motivated individuals to become part of the new Police Cadet program.

The program is designed to attract young men and women who are considering a career in law enforcement. Each individual begins as a Cadet I and advances to a Cadet II upon reaching certain milestones within the program. Cadet I must be a junior or senior in high school, display good citizenship, and maintain a grade point average of at least 2.5 or better. Cadet II must be at least 17 ½ years of age and must enroll or be enrolled in a degree-seeking program from an accredited degree granting college or university. Both levels are designed to maximize the potential for the different age groups and groom them into qualified police applicants.

The program will begin with 25 cadets and reach a maximum of 100 as the program evolves. Assistant Chief Hylton said, "It's a great program for young men and

women who need structure and discipline, as well as wanting to pursue a career in law enforcement”.
