1-Math By June 2025, the percentage of students who score proficient or distinguished will increase by at least five (5) percentage points on MCAP Mathematics, that is, from 28.68% to 31.68% for Elementary School and from 10.75% to 15.75% for Middle School. This requires at least 4 and 10 more students respectively to score proficient or distinguished on MCAP Mathematics.	The 3-Read Protocol is a reading strategy designed to enhance comprehension through three distinct readings of a text. In the first read, students focus on understanding the general meaning and context. The second read emphasizes identifying key details and analyzing specific elements, while the third read encourages deeper reflection, allowing students to synthesize their understanding and respond to prompts or questions. This structured approach helps students engage with the text more thoroughly and critically.		
2-RELA/ELA By June 2025, the percentage of students who score proficient or distinguished will increase by at least five (5) percentage points on MCAP RELA, that is, from 49.5% to 54.5% for Elementary School and from 61.61% to 66.61% for Middle School. This requires at least 5 more students to score proficient or distinguished on MCAP RELA.
