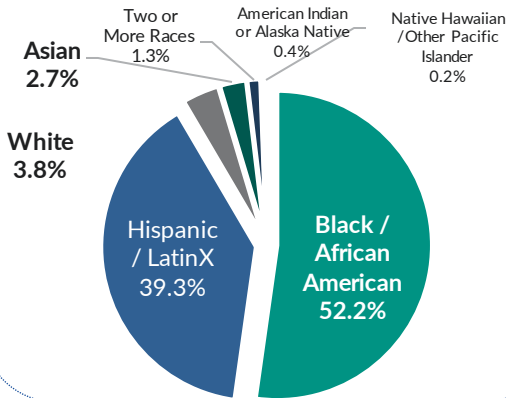

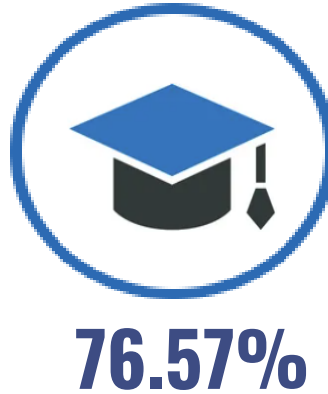

Graduation Rate 2022



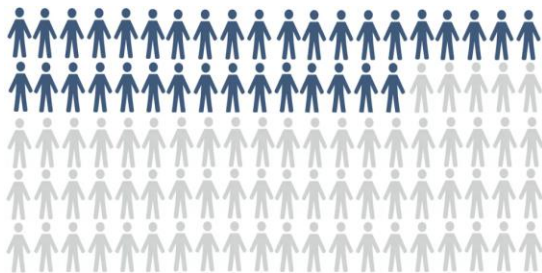

OUTCOME GOAL #1: EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE

PGCPS saw growth in Reading/Language Arts (ELA) proficiency scores across every grade level. Math proficiency scores declined across every grade level, with Grades 3-5 students showing the largest decline.

Reading English/Language Arts Proficiency

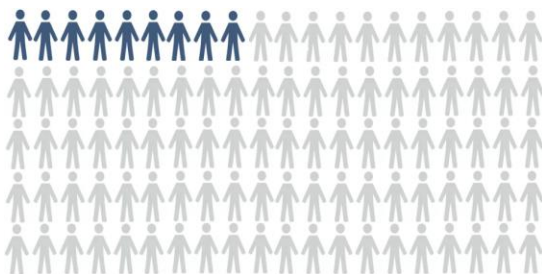

Percentage of students in grades 3 – 8 and Algebra 1 meeting expectations

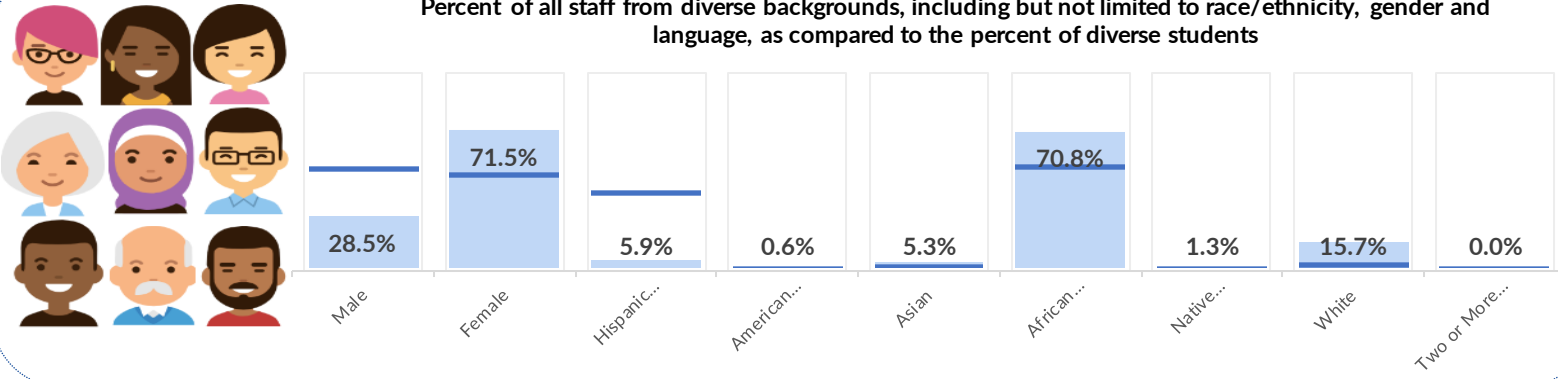
- 11.8% of grade 3-5 students met expectations

Percent of all staff from diverse backgrounds, including but not limited to race/ethnicity, gender and language, as compared to the percent of diverse students

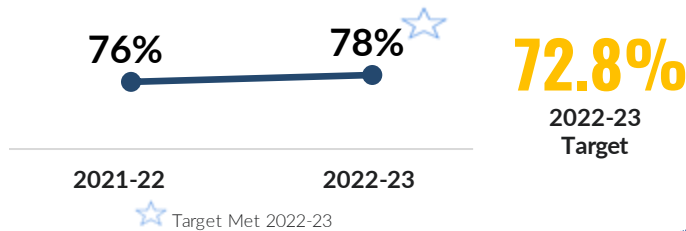


OUTCOME GOAL #3: WORKFORCE & OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE

Results from the 2022 Climate and Culture survey highlighted an increase in positive perceptions about collaboration opportunities and up-to-date facilities in PGCPS.

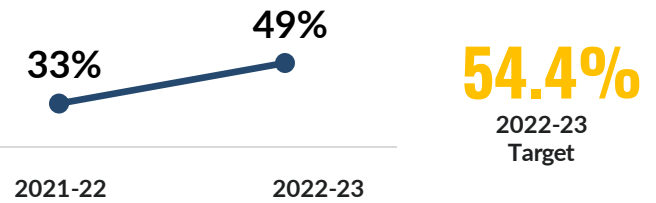
COLLABORATION

Percent of stakeholders agreeing that their school/building has up-to-date facilities

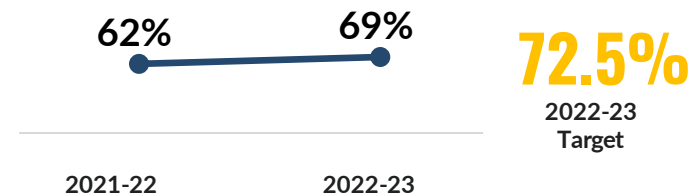


OUTCOME GOAL #4: MENTAL HEALTH & WELLNESS

Results from the 2022 Climate and Culture survey highlighted an increase in staff perceptions about delivering trauma-informed instruction but a reduction in stakeholders saying bullying is NOT a problem.
