



Robert Frost K-8 School Community Meeting | March 27, 2025 Questions & Answers

Do all classrooms have bathrooms?

Pre-K and Kindergarten classrooms will have bathrooms located inside the classroom. For grades 1 and up, restrooms will be located just outside the classrooms in the corridor. Each floor will also have group restrooms for students, and staff will have their own designated restrooms.

Will the school include a basketball court?

Yes. Indoors, there will be a full-size competition gymnasium with multiple basketball hoops, including both main and practice hoops. Outdoors, the school will feature a dedicated basketball court for recreational use.

Can you explain how traffic drop-off and pick-up will work?

For buses: Vehicles will enter Good Luck Road, pass through a designated loop that can accommodate approximately seven buses, and exit from the opposite side.

For parents: There will be a separate drop-off lane near the school building. Cars will enter through a different entrance, circulate through the parking lot, and exit back onto Good Luck Road. This separation of bus and car traffic is designed to improve efficiency and safety during arrival and dismissal times.

Will younger and older students be kept separate in the building?

Yes, the building layout separates elementary and middle school students by placing them in distinct wings. On each floor, the right side is designated for elementary grades, while the left side is for middle school students. Special education classrooms will be located on the ground floor. Connecting corridors include doors that can be closed to ensure students remain within their designated areas throughout the school day.
