



Templeton Elementary School Community Meeting | March 27, 2025 Questions & Answers

Will there be access to the upper floors from the outside?

Yes. The way the school is built, the land slopes, so you can enter the building from the outside on both the first and second floors. The third floor is higher up and can only be reached from inside using stairs or an elevator.

Where will the outdoor classrooms be located?

There will be several outdoor learning spaces across the school grounds. Some are formal areas specifically designed for teaching, like one marked “number six” on the map. Others are near the dining area and stage, plus there will be a garden and open spaces where teachers can take their classes outside.

Will we be able to access the school campus from Jennifer Place?

Not directly. Even though Jennifer Place is next to the school, the ground there is very steep. You’ll need to use the main entrances on Carter’s Lane or 60th Avenue to get in.

What will be the capacity of the school?

Templeton will serve students from Pre-K to 5th grade and will have space for about 650 students.

Will the school go to 8th grade?

Robert Frost, another school opening nearby serves up to 8th grade. Templeton will go only through 5th grade.
