

### What did we learn?



#### Student Feedback

-43% of students reported not needing any supports listed in the Assets and Needs Assessment

-19% of students always see their culture reflected in their education

-38% of students feel that their school is always preparing them to go to college and/or have a career



#### Staff Feedback

-91% of staff confirm that the school has a tool of identifying what area a student is struggling in

-55% of staff confirmed the use of whole-school programs to support students struggling with attendance



#### Family Feedback

-50% of families reported that they always see a connection between classroom instruction and real world experiences

-50% of families reported that their students can always speak candidly with the adults at the school

-83% of families report that the school always communicates in a way that their family understands



#### Community Feedback

-93% of community members reported that this school welcomes everyone

-95% of community members report that the school takes steps to ensure that each family feels welcome

- -Opportunities for staff to model effective instructional strategies learn from each other




#### Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice
