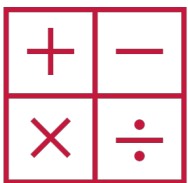

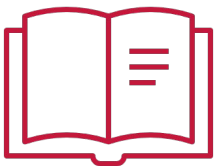

What did we learn?



Student Feedback

Students want stronger connections and support – they value teachers who listen, build relationships, and make them feel safe and respected in the school community.

Students seek engaging and challenging learning experiences – they prefer hands-on, relevant lessons with opportunities to collaborate, problem-solve, and show their creativity.

Students desire more enrichment and voice – they want access to clubs, activities, and leadership roles, as well as more opportunities to share their perspectives in shaping school life.



Staff Feedback

Staff want stronger systems of support – they identified a need for clearer structures, resources, and consistency in academic, behavioral, and social-emotional supports for students.

Staff value collaboration and shared leadership – they seek more time and structures for teamwork, professional learning communities, and opportunities to have input in schoolwide decisions.

Staff emphasize balance between rigor and care – they want to provide high-quality instruction while ensuring students' well-being, calling for strategies that support both academic excellence and emotional safety.

Family Feedback

Families want stronger communication and transparency – they value regular updates, clear expectations, and accessible ways to stay informed about their child's progress and school events.

Families seek meaningful engagement opportunities – they want to be welcomed as true partners in learning, with more chances to volunteer, attend workshops, and collaborate on school initiatives.

Families emphasize safety, care, and high expectations – they desire a nurturing environment where their children feel safe, supported, and academically challenged to reach their full potential.
