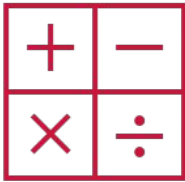

<p>Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities</p>	<p>Coordinate Partnerships for Field Trips: Collaborate with local museums, colleges, and businesses to provide meaningful, curriculum-aligned field trip experiences that expand students' exposure to careers, culture, and community resources.</p> <p>Enhance Academic Enrichment: Offer after-school and weekend programs, tutoring, and project-based learning opportunities that reinforce classroom instruction and accelerate academic growth.</p>
<p>Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice</p>	<p>Strengthen Inclusive Decision-Making: Establish structures such as advisory councils, student leadership groups, and family committees to ensure diverse voices shape school policies, programs, and priorities.</p> <p>Build Leadership Capacity Across Stakeholders: Provide training and opportunities for staff, families, and students to co-lead initiatives, fostering a culture of shared ownership and accountability.</p>
<p>Integrated Systems of Support</p>	<p>Coordinate Comprehensive Student Services: Align academic, behavioral, mental health, and social-emotional supports into a unified system to address the whole child and reduce barriers to learning.</p> <p>Leverage Community Partnerships: Integrate health, counseling, and family support services from local organizations to provide seamless wraparound care for students and families.</p>
<p>Culture of Belonging, Safety, and Care</p>	<p>Foster Inclusive and Supportive Environments: Create welcoming spaces where every student and family feels valued, respected, and represented through culturally responsive practices and celebrations.</p> <p>Prioritize Physical and Emotional Safety: Implement trauma-informed approaches, restorative practices, and clear safety protocols to ensure students feel secure and supported in all school settings.</p>
<p>Powerful Student and Family Engagement</p>	<p>Create Authentic Partnerships with Families: Involve families as co-creators of programs and decision-making processes through regular forums, workshops, and two-way communication channels.</p> <p>Empower Student and Family Voice in Learning: Provide opportunities for students and families to lead initiatives, share feedback, and shape enrichment activities and school culture.</p>
