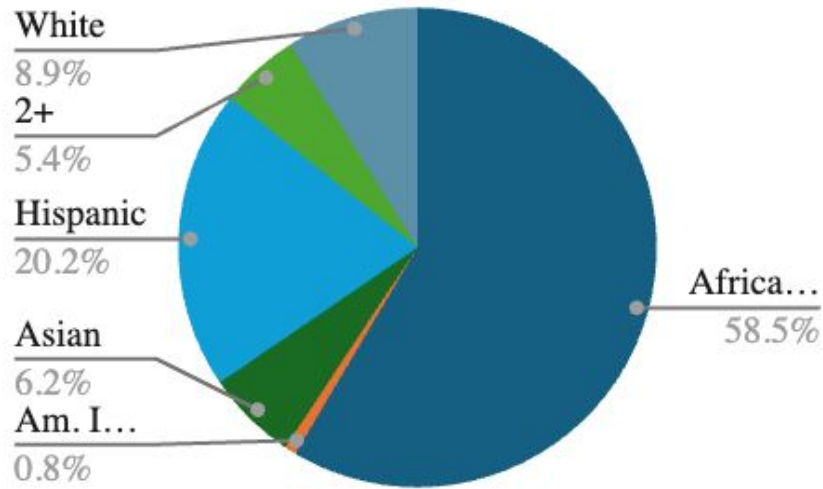
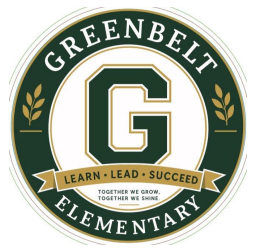
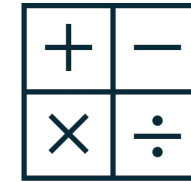

What did we learn?



Students

- Students feel comfortable and enjoy coming to school
- Students feel extremely supported during school hours by multi-layered systems of support



Staff

- Staff expressed freedom to openly collaborate, but limited changes due to lack of funding
- Increase in mental & behavioral support needed



Families

- Families would like to see parent, family engagement, events, and support services provided on a more consistent basis.
- Recent multiple leadership changes has affected trust and school culture



Community

- Expressed willingness to provide other support services, given funds are allocated to help support said services

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



As a school community we plan to:

- Bring in different vendors to provide services and instruction outside of the classroom enhancing student enrichment
- look to host more culturally enriching assemblies

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice



We aim to increase collaborative leadership by:

- Gaining more partnerships that are willing to provide services at minimal cost, to effectively enhance potential changes within the school building
- Consistently hosting PTA meetings and steering committee meetings to provide opportunities for collaborative leadership
