




#### Staff Feedback

- Mental Health & SEL: inadequate systems or identifying and addressing emotional needs
- **Behavior Supports:** Lack of school wide behavioral expectations or response svstems
- **Academic Intervention:** Staff know how's struggling but need better systems for targeted support
