What did we learn?

Staff Feedback

- Staff identified significant unmet student needs related to food insecurity, with 36% of staff reporting food insecurity among students/families.
- Staff observations indicate a substantial need for mental health and emotional support, including counseling and assistance with anxiety, sadness, anger, stress, and other social-emotional concerns.
- Staff identified reading and writing support as a significant academic priority, with 56% reporting that students need additional support.

of Support



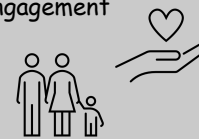
- Strengthen systems for identifying and responding to academic, mental health, basic-needs, and family-support needs.
- Improve awareness and access to existing school and community resources.
- Address basic needs such as food, clothing, and after-school care as part of supporting student success.

- Increase access to mental health and social-emotional supports.
- Ensure students have trusted adults and safe spaces where they can discuss feelings and challenges.
- Strengthen supports related to stress management, conflict resolution, and emotional regulation.
