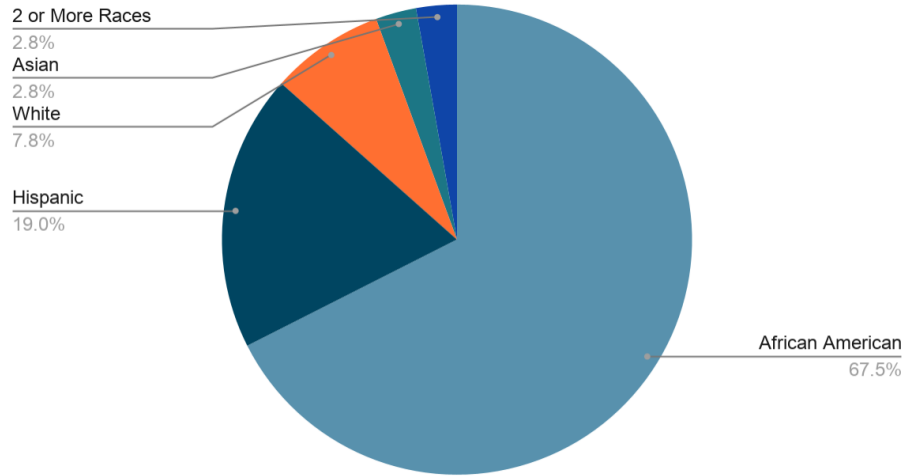
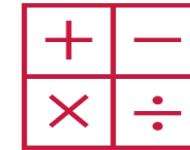

What did we learn?



- Students feel they can get the help they need when they need it.
- Students report that Extended Learning Opportunities (ELOs) are easily accessible.
- Students view their school as a welcoming and inclusive environment, reflecting a strong culture of belonging.



- A strong foundation exists for providing academic and behavioral interventions.
- Community partners are willing and ready to help make learning more meaningful and relevant for students.
- Students, families, staff, and community partners share positive perceptions of Northview Elementary school climate and culture.



- Families feel their school is a welcoming space, indicating a strong baseline culture.
- Families feel that school communicates clearly.
- Families feel that they can comfortably seek out their child's teacher.
- Community members feel that Northview values open communication and welcomes partner input.
- Community partners feel recognized, valued, and appreciated for their contributions.
- Community members report that they are willing to return and volunteer again.

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities



For **Northview Elementary**, the priorities are to make learning more relevant and culturally responsive in every classroom while expanding learning opportunities beyond the traditional school day. The school also has a valuable opportunity to use family engagement events as a bridge between home and school by helping families understand instructional practices, actively participate in their children's learning, and access enriched learning opportunities that support student achievement.

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice



The priority is to build **shared leadership** by giving families, students, and community partners a meaningful voice in school decisions. Northview will strengthen this work by developing leaders, and sharing school data openly so everyone shares responsibility for student success. Shared leadership distributes responsibility across the school community, while meaningful family engagement is built on shared decision-making, transparency, and collaboration.

Integrated Systems of Support



The priority at **Northview Elementary** is to build an accessible and equitable system of supports that removes barriers to student learning. The school has an opportunity to strengthen community partnerships, enhance its tiered support system, and create a family resource hub that connects families with both academic and non-academic services. Integrated student supports in community schools are designed to coordinate school and community resources to address barriers to learning while improving student success.

Culture of Belonging, Safety, and Care



At **Northview Elementary**, the priority is to create a safe, welcoming, and inclusive school where every student and family feels valued and supported. The school has an opportunity to celebrate diversity, improve language access, strengthen restorative practices, and expand social-emotional learning (SEL) and mental health supports to foster a culture of belonging and success.

Powerful Student and Family Engagement



The priority is to empower families and students as active partners in the school community. Northview has an opportunity to strengthen family engagement by co-planning events, developing family leaders, elevating student voice, and creating meaningful opportunities for all families to participate.
