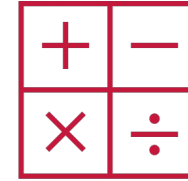

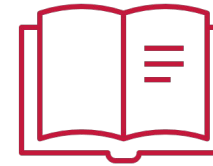

The school has a strong, positive climate where families feel welcomed and respected, with over 85% of families reporting that the school is inclusive and welcoming.

Powerful Student and
Family Engagement



The school has strong communication systems, with families reporting clear and consistent communication, and an existing parent leadership organization (PTO). Families also report feeling welcomed and generally engaged in school events.
