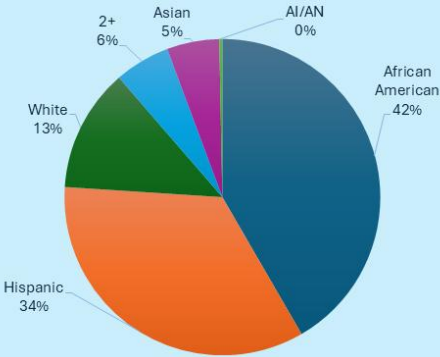

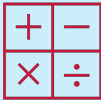


Student Demographics

Priorities and Opportunities

Rigorous, Community-Connected Classroom Instruction and Expanded, Enriched Learning Opportunities

- Math tutoring
- Additional outside of school time opportunities
- Continue opportunities to attend and participate in performances

Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice

- Develop SGA/student advisory council
- Increase community involvement in event development and planning
- Maintain and extend Community School Steering Committee
- Regular "Chat and Chew" community feedback sessions

Integrated Systems of Support

- Regular produce distributions
- Establish regular vision and dental support during school hours
- Provision of personal care and other needed basic care items

Culture of Belonging, Safety, and Care

- Focus on positive messaging
- Focus Groups
- Tools to facilitate engagement of all stakeholders – translation/interpretation, securing tools for direct communication (ie. PocketTalk)
- Continued staff training on trauma and restorative practices

Powerful Student and Family Engagement

- Continue to focus on having families participate in the planning of school events
- Student leadership/advisory council opportunities
- Professional development for staff on strategies for increasing family engagement
