What did we learn?



- Students feel welcomed and safe at school and feel they can talk with adults at the school.
- Students see their culture reflected in the school.
- Students feel a greater need to be involved in some of the decision making at school.

Broadening academic
support across grade levels



Seabrook Elementary is prioritizing the expansion of academic enrichment and intervention programs across more grade levels, with a focus on supporting the intermediate students. Community School funds will help provide targeted resources, instructional staff, and extended learning opportunities in English Language Arts and Math. These efforts aim to close learning gaps, accelerate student achievements, and ensure every student can succeed academically.
