What did we learn?



Student Feedback

- Student Support: The school has tools to identify struggling students in academics (90%), attendance (100%), and behavior (90%), showing strong monitoring systems.



Family Feedback

- Family Engagement: 76.9% of families report a parent leadership organization exists, and 74.5% say the school always holds family/community events.



Staff Feedback

- Approximately 70.0% of school staff report that they frequently communicate to students and their families through email or other computer-based electronic communications. 80.0% of school staff say that they never communicate with students and their families through social media.



Community Feedback

- Community Resource Awareness: About 50% of families feel they "always" or "sometimes" can access help with health, vision, and emotional support through the school.

Tayac ES will strengthen instruction by engaging community partners to connect learning to real careers and civic life, while using ongoing assessment data (MAP, MCAP, iReady) to guide small-group and differentiated instruction. Enrichment will include themed literacy and math programs and family learning nights that link academics to culture and real-world skills. Rigor and enrichment will be documented through lesson plans, walk-throughs, and participation logs to demonstrate progress toward Blueprint goals.

Tayac ES will achieve Collaborative Leadership, Shared Power, and Voice by empowering staff through leadership teams and teacher-led initiatives, amplifying student voice through councils and goal-setting, and engaging families and community partners in decision-making.
