Inclement Weather Make-Up Days

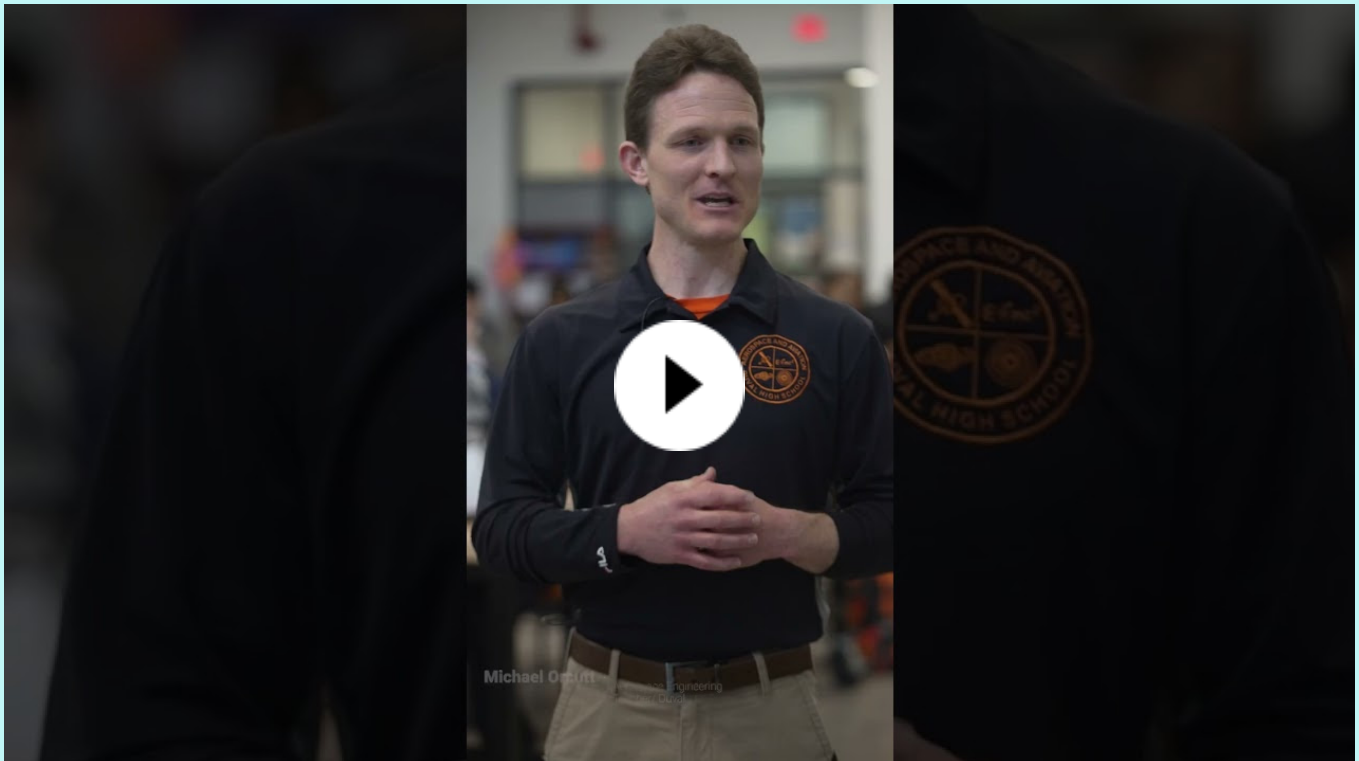


EMERGENCY WEATHER ALERT
