
School Construction Model Earns International Award!



The PGCPS Blueprint Schools program was named Social Infrastructure Project of the Year this week at the P3 Awards – the second international award for this first-of-its-kind school financing model! PGCPS is the first public school system in the nation to leverage a full-scope alternative financing model for a multi-school construction program. Six new schools will open by 2023 under the first phase of the program: Adelphi, Drew-Freeman, Hyattsville, Kenmoor and Walker Mill middle schools and a new kindergarten through eighth grade academy in Fort Washington named for Colin L. Powell.


New Suitland High School Town Hall



Mount Rainier Elementary Receives Gift for School Improvements




Mount Rainier Elementary School received a \$100,000 gift from Heart of America for renovations including new desks and student seating, flooring, inspirational graphics and more!
