



Deadlines Extended to Accept High School Specialty Program

If you have received notification that your child has been accepted into or waitlisted for the Science and Technology, Aerospace Engineering and Aviation Technology or International Baccalaureate (IB) program, you must first complete the online intent form to ensure you will move on to the next step in the placement process. Once notified of placement, you must accept your child's seat using your Scriborder account.

The deadline to complete intent forms has been extended to **Wednesday**, **April 6**. The deadline to accept placement has been extended to **Monday**, **April 11**.


Deadline Extended: Share Your Post-Graduation Plans and **Enter to Win a Chromebook**




A Night of Artificial Intelligence!
