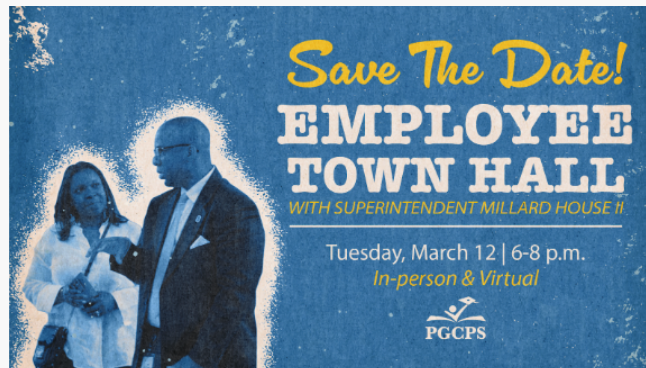

FY25 Requested Operating Budget Advances to Council

The Board of Education's [FY 2025 Requested Operating Budget](#) was unanimously approved. Next steps include approval by Prince George's County Council by June 1 and a final vote by the Board on reconciled changes.
