UPPER MARLBORO, MD – Information on available summer programs is now available on the Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS) website. Summer programs offer eligible students in all grade levels the opportunity for acceleration, enrichment, credit recovery, and original credit.

Elementary and early childhood learners can benefit from enriching summer experiences through the Head Start Extended Year Program, the Judy Center Extended Year Program, or the Special Education Extended School Year Program. Middle school students will find opportunities to participate in Credit Recovery and the SIG Extended Year Program (Title I). Five bridge programs are available to rising 9th grade students. Those programs include: Aerospace Engineering and Aviation Technology, Algebra I, AVID Math and Science, Biology, and Science and Technology.

To support academic promotion and graduation, high school students will find program offerings such as: Academic Validation: High School Assessment, ACCESS Online, Blended Learning Online Credit Recovery, and the Credit Recovery and Original Credit Program. The following summer programs are also available to high school students: Advanced Placement (AP) Academy, International Baccalaureate (IB) Instructional Support, JROTC Cadet Leadership (COLP), and SAT 101 - Princeton Review.

To register, students must obtain a registration form from their school counselor. Registration dates and times are listed in the guide under each summer program.

Tuition waiver forms are available for credit recovery programs only. Tuition may be waived by 25 percent, or less of the full price of one course per student for students who qualify for free or reduced meals. Completed waiver forms signed by the student's principal must be submitted at the time of registration. Only PGCPS students are eligible for tuition waivers.

Meals and transportation will be provided at select program sites. Program start times vary by site. To find program start times, or to find out if meals are provided click, here.
