|  | ACCEPTABLE (Can Wear) | UNACCEPTABLE (Cannot Wear) <br> Appropriate disciplinary action will be taken when students do not adhere to mandatory uniform dress code. |
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| Shirts/Tops | - Navy blue Polo shirts ONLY with NO logos on the shirt. Shirts can be long or short sleeve. <br> - All undershirts must be white and worn under the shirt and cannot be visible. <br> - Shirts are strongly encouraged to be tucked in uniform bottoms. | - T-shirts are NOT acceptable <br> - Shirts MUST be plain in color and cannot have any design logos, characters, names or numbers of any kind. <br> - Undershirts and t-shirts should not be visible--out of the sleeves of shirt and MUST be plain (no writing). <br> - Students CANNOT wear another color shirt in lieu of their uniform shirt. |
| Other Tops | - Sweater/Cardigan: Solid black or navy blue sweater/cardigan | - Sweater/Cardigan cannot have hoods, designs, logos, characters, names or numbers. |
| Bottoms: Pants, Skirts, Jumper/Dress, Skorts and Shorts (Warmer months) | - Tan khaki bottoms are REQUIRED. <br> - Elastic waist bottoms are allowed. <br> - Bottoms must have a finished hem line. <br> - Uniform pants can be worn SECURELY with a belt around the waist (optional). <br> - Skirts, Skorts and Shorts must be tan khaki and fall within six (6) inches below the buttocks, or not shorter than fingertip level. | - No cargo pants <br> - No splitting or cutting of pants at the hem or bottom <br> - No pants with characters, letters, numbers or designs of any kind. <br> - No leggings. <br> - Pants or shorts with patches, designs or lettering are NOT allowed. <br> - Pants cannot be rolled up or tucked into shoes or boots. |
| Socks/Tights | - Solid white socks/solid white tights, solid black socks/solid | - Socks/Tights cannot have characters, multi-color print, |


|  | black tights or solid navy blue socks/navy blue tights are acceptable. <br> - Tights or shorts (when wearing socks) should be worn under dresses/jumpers. | or designs, holes, names or anything dangling <br> - No leggings. |

| Shoes | - Solid black, solid brown or navy blue soft bottom or solid black tennis shoes are acceptable. <br> - Shoes with Velcro to secure are permitted. <br> - Boots (solid black, solid brown or navy blue) are only worn when there is a snow day and during inclement weather. | - Shoes may not contain colored stripes, additional colors, characters, names, letters, and designer insignias of any size. <br> - Wearing snow boots when there is no snow is NOT permitted. <br> - No sandals, slippers, or flipflops. Both feet must be fully covered. |
| Belts | - Solid Brown, solid black or navy blue | - Belts with designs, colorful or large buckles are NOT allowed. <br> - No belts hanging on the side. |
| Head Covering | As is stated in the PGCPS System-Wide Dress Code for Students, "Headdress may be worn indoors for religious or health reasons only". |  |

## Additional Requirements/Notes

Jewelry: Any jewelry worn should be small and age appropriate. Any student wearing large, cumbersome, dangly jewelry or accessories will be asked to remove said items.

Coats and Jackets: Students will not be permitted to wear coats or jackets during the school day except in the case of a heating emergency.
Footwear: Rain or snow boots may be worn to school, however, students will be required to change into regular shoes or tennis shoes upon entering their classroom.
Head: No hats or any headdress can be worn except for recognized religious or health reasons.

## Uniform Violations

FIRST violation: The school representative will contact the parents/guardians by phone, send home a uniform violation letter and notify administration.

SECOND violation: The school representative will contact the parents/guardians by phone, send home a second notice and contact administration.

THIRD violation: The administration will call the parent/guardian and send home a written notification.

FOURTH violation: The administration will arrange a parent conference to reiterate the parameters of the policy and the consequences of future violations. Written notification will be sent home documenting the conference.

FIFTH violation: The student will be removed from class by administration and the student complete classroom assignments provided by the teacher in another part of the school.

SIXTH violation: A parent/student conference will be held with administration and teacher. A final warning will be issued, advising them that another violation will result in a determination of intervention according to Prince George's County Public Schools Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook, Section Six (6): Disciplinary Responses, Code of Student Conduct, Failure to comply with school dress code, All Grades (AG) (Grade Level), 1 / 2 (Level of Response).
