



FAQs for Concord Elementary School Boundary and Consolidation

Questions:

1. What are the current utilization rates for the receiving schools?

After receiving PreK-5 students from Concord Elementary and reassigning sixth grade to the assigned middle school the following utilization rates are projected for school year 2023-24:

- Doswell E. Brooks Elementary - 61% utilization;
- Francis Scott Key Elementary - 66% utilization; and
- John H. Bayne Elementary - 73% utilization.

2. Does the utilization data provided reflect new housing developments?

There are currently no significant new housing developments planned in the Rose Valley attendance area.

3. Can you provide the current student-teacher ratios for PGCPS?

The student teacher ratio can vary depending on the size of the grade cohort and educational needs of groups of students. PGCPS recommended student-teacher ratios will be adhered to.

4. What was the enrollment when the research was done?

The latest official enrollment is September 30, 2021. These numbers were utilized as the base to project enrollments for new boundaries.

5. Did anyone look at the census data to see how many students would be enrolling in the next 2-3 years?

PGCPS produces updated 10-year enrollment projections by school and grade for every spring. These numbers are published in the annual [Educational Facilities Master Plan](#).

6. Are any of the receiving schools mandatory uniform schools?

Uniforms are mandatory at all three receiving schools.

7. When was the consolidation survey done?

The survey was available from June to December 2021.
