All volunteers, except one-time event volunteers, are required to complete the assigned SafeSchools training modules prior to volunteering. Upon completion of each training module, the volunteer should provide you with a copy of their certificates of completion. Three modules have been assigned to volunteers to complete. They are: PGCPS Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse and Neglect; PGCPS Student Safety Procedural Changes; and Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure Prevention.
