ELD Writing Task

Starting December 1 through December 19, all ELD students will be completing the mid-year ELD Writing Task.

The more opportunities our ML students have to practice their writing skills, the more they learn about and develop their language skills.

Please provide students the opportunity to practice writing (also speaking, listening and reading) at home, so they can further develop their English language skills.

WIDA ACCESS Testing

Beginning in January, ALL ELD students will complete the WIDA ACCESS Test. ACCESS is a yearly assessment that measures the English language proficiency of students who are identified as Multilingual Learners.

This assessment is extremely important and valuable, because it allows us to see the growth your child has made in their language development. It also helps to determine the type of ELD services your child will receive at school.
