Concepts our Prekindergarten teachers demonstrated consistently

Teacher Sensitivity- The teachers effectively identified students who needed extra support, assistance or attention. She was consistently responsive to students' needs.

Organization of Lesson- The teachers effectively facilitated students' involvement during lessons.

Maximizing Learning Time- Students demonstrated an understanding of classroom routines as they transitioned to various components of the day.

Areas our Prekindergarten teachers can improve to support student success

Concept Development- Intentionally integrate concepts to the students' lives and with previously learned concepts.

Quality Feedback- Intentionally provide specific information to expand or clarify students' learning and to provide specific encouragement or affirmation.

Language Modeling- Intentionally ask more open ended questions that begin with why and how across all activities.
