Greetings Families,

We are committed to providing every student at Seabrook Elementary School with a high-quality education that supports academic and personal growth. As part of this commitment and in accordance with the federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), I want to inform you that Seabrook Elementary School has been identified by the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) as a school in Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI).

This designation is based on our school's performance in one or more areas, including student achievement, growth, and the performance of student performance groups. Specifically, our students with disabilities did not meet the academic targets in English Language Arts and Math.

Being designated as a school in improvement provides us with a valuable opportunity to focus on strengthening instruction, enhancing student supports, and building partnerships with families. Our team has developed a school improvement plan that includes:

- Providing targeted academic interventions and extended learning opportunities, including the use of Imagine Learning to support multilingual learners, as well as math and reading interventions in partnership with Tutor Partners.
- Offering ongoing professional development for teachers on effective ELD strategies, reading and math small-group instruction, and multimodal learning to support the needs of all learners, including students receiving special education services. Professional learning will also include learning walks to strengthen instructional practices.
- Regularly monitoring student progress to guide instruction and ensure that students are on track toward meeting grade-level expectations.
- Hosting family engagement events, such as academic nights and Data University, to equip families with strategies and resources that support learning at home.

We appreciate your partnership and continued support in the effort to improve and meet our school's goals. We invite you to join us for a School Improvement Information Night on October 21, 2025 at 6:00pm to learn more about this school improvement designation and share your input. You are encouraged to stay in communication with your child's teachers about your child's academic progress and share your ideas on how we can improve together.
