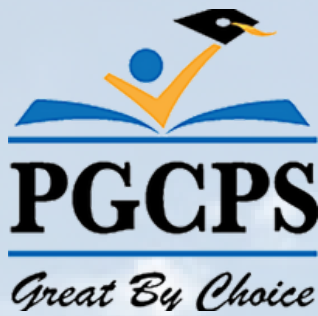
REPORT CARDS

Friendly High School welcomes new community and parent partners. As we build our PTSA community, we welcome all to participate and work together with us as we support Friendly High School.



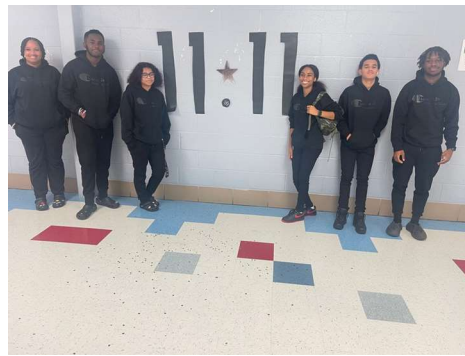
Friendly High School's Annual Turkey Basket give-away.

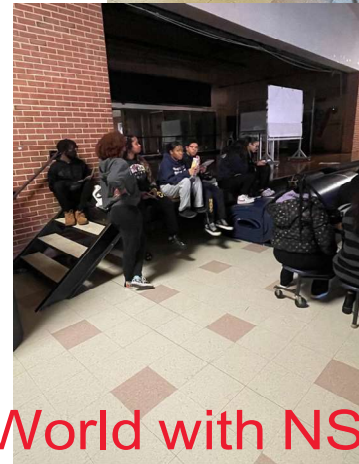
